Parents,

In the spring, RBMS students will take the Georgia Milestones Assessment. Your child may begin practicing now for the End of Grade (EOG) assessment. The primary purpose of the practice test is to let students experience what online testing is like. The practice test will also familiarize students with the format of the assessment and the online tools they will have access to during the EOG. The practice is not graded and students may sign in as many times as needed. Follow the directions below to begin practicing:

iPad Instructions:

- 1. Click on DRC INSIGHT icon on iPad and choose Georgia or go to www.gaexperienceonline.com (in Chrome) and choose Test Practice "Online Tools Training" under End-of-Grade (EOG) Spring Main
- 2. Click on "EOG Test Practice"
- 3. Click on "Standard Online Tools" OR if your child has test questions read to them, choose "Audio, Masking, Color Contrast and Color Chooser"
- 4. Click on Grades 6-8
- 5. Type in the Username and Password provided on the screen
- 6. Press Continue on the screen that says "Please raise your hand and wait for help."
- 7. Press Yes to confirm the self-lock app
- 8. Press Continue on the Welcome screen
- 9. Click on Grades 6-8 Practice Test
- 10. Read the instructions and press next to proceed to the practice test
- 11. Begin the test
- 12. Click Next to proceed through the practice test
- 13. Click End Test when finished with the practice
- 14. Click Submit (answers will not be graded)
- 15. Click Exit to get back to the login screen (or Grade 3-5 Test Practice to restart training)

Personal Computer Instructions:

- 1. Go to www.gaexperienceonline.com (in Chrome)
- 2. Click on Test Practice (or choose Tutorial to watch a short demonstration video which explains how to use all testing tools)
- 3. Click on "Online Tools Training" under End-of-Grade (EOG) Spring Main
- 4. Click on EOG Test Practice
- 5. Click on "Standard Online Tools" OR if your child has test questions read to them, choose "Audio, Masking, Color Contrast and Color Chooser"
- 6. Click on Grades 6-8
- 7. Type in the Username and Password provided on the screen
- 8. Press Continue on the Welcome screen
- 9. Click on Grades 6-8 Practice Test
- 10. Read the instructions and press next to proceed to the practice test
- 11. Begin the test
- 12. Click Next to proceed through the practice test
- 13. Click End Test when finished with the practice
- 14. Click Submit (answers will not be graded)
- 15. Click Exit to get back to the login screen (or Grade 6-8 Test Practice to restart training)
